**Junior Report – Nov 2024 Executive meeting**

### **Junior League**

The Junior League has settled down into a very good competition and the final results show close matches.

The final was played at Ruddington Grange GC on Sun 13 Oct – the final was between Worksop GC and Norwood Park GC with Worksop claiming a good victory by 3 matches to 2.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> place play off was between the two Oakmere teams with Oakmere North winning on the day.

### **Four Counties Tournament**

Once again, despite poor weather an excellent tournament was held at Formby GC in early April. Our boys struggled in the very difficult conditions against excellent opponents and ended up bottom of the table.

### **England Golf Midland Region Qualifier (10 Counties)**

Notts again fielded a very strong team at Overstone Park GC and had high hopes of improving on the previous year's performances which had seen us in 5<sup>th</sup> place. County Junior Captain Will Burbidge again led the team to a very creditable 5<sup>th</sup> place.

### **U14 Four Counties**

Once again an excellent U14 tournament was held at Alfreton GC against Derbyshire, Warwickshire, and Staffordshire. Our boys came up against very strong opposition and we ended up in 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall

### **MGU U14 Ten Counties**

This tournament was played at the Longcliffe GC on Sun 1st Sept. The Notts boys all played well and as a team again ended up in 5<sup>th</sup> place. Heath Dixon was our leading player and was individual 6<sup>th</sup> place.

### **MGU U16 County Cup (Ten Counties)**

This tournament was played at the Manor GC, Uttoxeter on Sun 29 Sept. We fielded a very strong team but were no match for the team from Derbyshire who ran out convincing winners. The Notts boys all played well and as a team ended up in 5<sup>th</sup> place.

### **MGU Champion of Champions**

This tournament was played at Stourbridge GC on Sun 22 Sept in very poor weather. The County was represented by Kai Krishnan, Ethan Wan and William Psenko who all acquitted themselves very well – in particular William Psenko who won the U14 and U16 championships and was overall runner up – a fantastic achievement.

### **County Coaching Squads**

The restructuring of the Junior Coaching squads started in 2023 continues – this is based on ability as per the advice from EG. This has again proved to be a great success and along with the continued input and support from the 3 County Coaches has, in my opinion been the single biggest move forward for a number of years. The invites for 2025 have been sent out and this year includes a Player/Union agreement setting what is required from players and the Union  
The Nippers Tour managed by Pete Lockley and Tom Warnock has gone from strength to strength with almost 50 boys and girls signed up. The professional set up and fantastic prize table has added to the continuing success of the Tour. In 2025, the upper age limit will be increased to 13 years.

### **08 Junior League – Peter Trotter – Chair of Junior Golf**

There will be no changes to the fixtures and the league will be sorted by the end of February. Everything will be the same as last year and he asked for entries by clubs to be made by the end of January. Mandy Bee will be sending an email out next week inviting clubs to enter the Junior League 2025.

The Chair had received an email from Oakmere saying they are disappointed there is no memento/prize for winning the league. They suggested each club to pay £25.00 per match to go towards the prize fund or the Union to provide funds. The amount they suggested would be around £1.000 in prize vouchers. The chair explained no other scratch league receives any prize funding and if the Junior Organisers wanted to go ahead with this then they themselves would have to delegate someone to collect monies, as the union does not get involved. He asked the Executive what their thoughts/suggestions were on the matter.

## **Response**

### **Points made by the Executive:**

- **Not a good idea as it just complicates everything.**
- **Getting a team together is hard enough in general.**
- **The Union give shields to each division and also provide a salver for the winning club, runners up and third place. A facility fee is also paid to the club for letting us play in the finals.**
- **Having money involved is not necessary.**
- **A suggestion is to have a salver for each player on the winning team as a memento next year.**
- **How does the money get divided at the end of season as some players may have only played in the finals and they would receive the voucher which would be unfair.**
- **It should be about just representing your club and participating in the league.**
